
## WARRANT ARTICLE #5

# 100 ft. Buffer for Select 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> Order Streams

### 1st - 4th Order Stream Buffer



### **100' buffer applies only to:**

Little River –  $(1^{st} \text{ order})$ Old River –  $(1^{st}/2^{nd} \text{ order})$ Nilus Brook -  $(1^{st}/2^{nd} \text{ order})$ Ash Brook –  $(2^{nd} \text{ order})$ Drakes River –  $(2^{nd}/3^{rd} \text{ order})$ Winnicut River –  $(1^{st}/2^{nd}/3^{rd} \text{ order})$ Taylor River –  $(4^{th} \text{ order})$ 

The 100' tiered buffer has three components, vegetation, fertilizer use, and development. Current uses and structures are grandfathered.

- 0-25 feet: "Vegetated Buffer Strip" Invasive plant removal by hand and application of lime only.
- 25-50 feet: "Limited Cut Area" Cut live trees with a diameter of four and one-half (4-1/2) inches or less, measured four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level is permitted.

Application of lime only.

• 0-75 feet: No structures allowed
