3.40 Family Day Child Care, meaning taking care of up to six preschool children on a full-time basis and three school age children on a part-time basis as an accessory use to the principal use of the property. The home shall be the primary residence of the provider. A license from the Bureau of Child Care Standards & Licensing, Division of Public Health Services of the NH Department of Health & Welfare is required. The Family Child Care program shall fully comply with the NH Department of Health and Human Services Part He-C 4002 NH Child Care Program Licensing Rules. Conditions for a special exception include, minimal impact on the neighborhood, no adverse traffic impact, safe off street drop-off and pickup area, and a safe outdoor play area. No Planning Board approval is required.\*

3.41 Group Family day Child Care, meaning a child care facility program operated in a home which is the primary residence of the provider. This is an accessory use to the principal use of the property, which involves at least one provider and one family child care worker or assistant caring for 7 to 12 preschool children plus up to 5 school age children. taking care of more than six children on a full-time basis by at least two caregivers that is licensed by the Bureau of Child Care Standards and Licensing, Division of Public Health Services of the NH Department of Health and Welfare. The Group Family Child Care program shall fully comply with the NH Department of Health and Human Services Part He-C 4002 NH Child Care Program Licensing Rules. No Planning Board approval is required.\*
